To take free classes to prepare for your high school diploma, you must:

- ✓ Live in Illinois.
- ✓ Be at least 18 years old.
 - → 16 and 17-year-old students may register with an official release letter certifying they are no longer attending high school.
- × Students do **not** need to have a Social Security number or be a United States citizen to enroll.
- × Students with F1, F2, J1, or J2 visas are **not** eligible to
- × Short-term visitors to the United States are **not** able to enroll.

Free classes are available at all skill levels. You can prepare for your high school diploma in person, online, during the day, at night, and even on weekends.
